Definitions to Figure Out Who You Are:

- **WSC INTERN (WSC INTERN)**: you are pursuing licensure through our traditional teacher education on-campus program as an undergraduate or a Post BA student and are working directly with a mentor teacher in their classroom
- **TEACH NOW INTERN (TN INTERN)**: you are pursuing licensure through the Teach Now Program and are working directly with a mentor teacher in their classroom
- **TEACH NOW ALTERNATIVE TEACHER (ALTERNATIVE)**: you are pursuing licensure through the Teach Now Program and are the paid teacher of record in your own classroom.
