Individualized Contract Emphasis Requirements

- The student must submit a proposal that provides a rationale and organizing concept and includes a) the student's goals and career plans; b) a sequence of courses; c) an explanation of how the sequence addresses the goals.
- The contract must be approved by a committee of three individuals selected by the student. One must be an ENVS Council member. One of the other two must be a WSC faculty member.
- 16 credits are required for the emphasis, and at least 12 of the credits must be in upper division courses.
- The student must successfully complete all 100- and 200- level courses in the ENVS core prior to completing upper -division course work in the emphasis.
- All individualized contracts must include a 1-6 credit internship...
- The student must have an overall GPA of 3.0 or above and an ENVS GPA of 3.2 or above at the time the contract is approved.
