

## **COURSE NUMBERING**

### **Prior to 1965:**

1-99           undergraduate, lower-division courses

100-199       undergraduate, upper-division courses

200-299       graduate courses

### **Effective with winter quarter, 1965:**

200-299       graduate courses, open to qualified upper-division undergraduates  
(undergraduate credit indicated with a U following the number, e.g.  
200U)

300-399       graduate courses, graduate students only

## **GRADING**

### **Grading from 1911-1965:**

A = 3 points, Excellent. B = 2 points, Superior. C = 1 point, Average. D = 0 points, Passing. F = negative 1 point, Failing. In or Inc = Incomplete. NC or NCD = No Credit Desired.

### **Grading from 1965-1971:**

A = 4 points, Superior. B = 3 points, Excellent. C = 2 points, Satisfactory. D = 1 point, Poor - Probationary. F = 0 points, Failing. In or Inc = Incomplete. NC or NCD = 0 points, No Credit Desired. FD = 0 points, Drop Failure.
