

## **WRAP Project Coordinator Western's Resist Alcohol Program**

Western State College of Colorado has received a 2 year Federal grant to develop or enhance, implement, and evaluate Campus and/or Community-Based strategies to prevent high-risk drinking among college students. We are seeking to hire a WRAP Project Coordinator.

**Responsibilities:** The WRAP Project Coordinator will create, organize, implement and oversee alcohol-free activities and events which will take place after class, in the evenings and on the weekends, during the day, evening and late night. This programming is designed to provide students with alternative activities in order to decrease alcohol use. Activities that have had high student involvement in the Spring semester will be repeated and augmented in the Fall semester. Activities will be innovative and closely tied to student interest as identified through characteristics of our student body and the ideas of student leaders. Suggestions to date include "Wii" tournaments, Ultimate Frisbee tournaments, Poker tournaments, movie nights, dodge ball, volleyball, ice-skating, moonlight hikes, overnight excursions through Wilderness Pursuits and pool parties. The Project Coordinator will work with the Steering Committee, the Project Director, the Associate VP for Student Affairs, and other key personnel on campus to assist in implementing strategies and delivering programs. The WRAP Project Coordinator is also a liaison to GCSAPP (Gunnison County Substance Abuse Program). The Project Coordinator will also oversee the administration of e-chug, advise a student organization and will help develop an online interactive orientation program which includes questions related to the alcohol rules and penalties on campus and in the City of Gunnison. This online program would be implemented in the Spring of Year One of the grant for all students. In subsequent semesters of the grant funding period, all new students (freshmen and transfers) will receive the orientation program. The Coordinator will also oversee the administration of the CORE drug and alcohol survey to a sample of students each spring.

**Qualifications:** The Project Coordinator will hold a minimum of a Master's degree in Counseling or an associated area of expertise to provide 1-on-1 counseling when appropriate. A certificate or focus in the area of alcohol abuse is helpful. The successful applicant should have leadership, management and communication skills, as well as excellent writing ability and some familiarity with technology. While this is a full-time position, hours are flexible but daily office hours are required, as well as the ability to work evenings and some weekends

**Compensations/Benefits:** This is a 2 year federal grant allowing for a salary of \$30,000 annually, and includes a yearly budget for programming. Benefits include an employee/employer shared contribution retirement plan, life and health insurance.
