

Ethics in Leadership

Situational Leader: Person who is a good leader in a given situation, maybe in a specific role

Relational Leader: Builds relationships with others and through those relationships empowers others to rise up.

Positional Leader: Someone in a specific position of leadership

Charismatic Leader: Their personality attracts people to follow them.

Participant Leader: Someone not in a leadership role, but is a member of a group. People tend to follow this person. This person is someone who leads by example.
