Whereas: The College Jib Jam 2008 aims to bring together students from all over Colorado, New Mexico, Utah, and Wyoming for a rail jam taking place December 6th at Crested Butte Mountain Resort. The Jib Jam aims to bring the competitors to us, here in the Gunnison Valley.

Whereas: This event will be taking place at Crested Butte Mountain Resort on December 6th. Registration will take place from 9-12am, and competition will take place from 1-3pm. This will be the first free ride competition held at Crested Butte this season, and a larger than normal rail park will be constructed to complement the skills of skiers and boarders. Multiple categories for competitors will ensure a friendly laid back atmosphere that all skill levels can enjoy.

Whereas: College Jib Jam 2008 is sending flyers to schools in an attempt to draw students to Crested Butte to participate. Additional incentives will include \$30 lift tickets and lodging specials, many prizes to competitors as well as raffle prizes, an after party at the Lobar, and other on mountain perks.

Whereas: The College Jib Jam has seen a tremendous response from large corporate sponsors giving large amounts of product to the project as competitor prizes and raffle items. The Jib Jam however is having difficulty securing the needed amount of funds to take care of things such as printing of flyers, mailings, bibs, food/beverage, and other necessary supplies.
